Credit Union Youth Week! April 19th - 24th

Saving your money isn't always easy, especially when you don't have a lot to spare. After paying all your usual expenses, there may be very little "fun" money at the end of the month. When we do find ourselves with some extra cash, like a tax refund, many of us rush out to buy those shoes or that electronic gadget we've been eying for months instead of putting it into our savings.

Why do we do that? Why do we spend the money we planned on using for our future?

We can blame it on our brains. Behavioral science has shown that humans are hard-wired to act on impulse and that it takes conscious thought to delay gratification. It's also much easier to focus on the present than our future.

Critical Financial Security Precautions

- Never give your personal or financial information unless you initiated the exchange. In particular, members should never volunteer their date of birth, account numbers, or Social Security numbers.
- Never let a seller overcharge you for a product or service you need. Get more than one estimate before committing to pay a price.
- If you're not sure whether you need a seller's product or service, you should not let anyone convince you to make a commitment on the spot. Take time away from the sales pitch to discuss the offer with family or friends, check the company's references, and verify claims. If salespeople are being pushy, that's a red flag; they may not have the consumer's best interests at heart.
- Never let a seller pressure you to sign a document you don't understand.
 Reputable purveyors of goods and services should provide time for consumers to ask questions and seek legal advice.
- If you suspect a scam, report it to police immediately. By reporting fraud or suspected fraud, there's a much better chance of recovering any losses and preventing another unsuspecting person from becoming the next victim.
