
Looking ahead, we remain dedicated to growth, innovation, and exceptional member service. Thank you for being an

For the year ending December 31, 2024, we hired Barfield, Murphy, Shank and Smith, LLC (BMSS) of Birmingham, Alabama, to conduct an independent comprehensive audit. This year the financial statements fairly represent the financial results achieved during 2024 and that the practices and procedures followed are in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in the United States of America.







2023 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES - APRIL 28, 2024

Family Savings Credit Union held its Annual Meeting at the Venue, Gadsden, Alabama at 2:00 p.m. Meeting called to order by Mr. Pat Williamson, Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Quorum present. Mr. Will McCarty was appointed Parliamentarian.

Prayer by Mr. Frankie Letson.

Mr. Pat Williamson welcomed all members and thanked them for their continued support and for their attendance at the Annual Meeting. Mr. Williamson also thanked the employees and volunteers. He also introduced the Board, Supervisory Committee, and alternate Board members. He stated that our deposits were up 28% and loans were up 18% over the last year. He also stated that the E. Gadsden and Rockmart branches had a renovation this year. He made the membership aware of the All-in program where we are making an impact on our community. We've also partnered with JSU to teach financial literacy to their students.

The minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Calvin Hutchinson introduced the members of the Supervisory Committee and explained its purpose. Mr. Hutchinson thanked the other 2 members of the Supervisory Committee, Lane Hill and Dan Baldwin, for their service, as well as the Alternate Board Members, Misty Silvey and Bruce Phillips.

Mr. Wally Burns, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, gave the Nominating Committee report. The committee recommended to serve a three (3) year term on the Board of Directors:

Mr. Bill Willard Mr. Ronnie Reed

For the Supervisory Committee, to serve a three (3) year term: Mr. Dan Baldwin

For the Supervisory Committee, to serve a two (2) year term: Mr. Lane Hill

Mr. Pat Williamson declared by acclamation those nominated by the Nominating Committee are duly elected.

Mr. Danny Varnon gave the President's report. He thanked everyone for coming out. He stated that FSCU grew to \$965,000,000 at the end of 2023. \$10,000,000 was paid out in dividends and \$10,000,000 was put in reserves. March 31, 2024 we hit \$1,400,000,000. We will be adding 2 new locations this year in Food City stores. One in Ft. Payne and one in Huntsville.

Mr. Danny Varnon presented 3 scholarships of \$3,000 each to local students. Colby Bishop was the recipient of the Audra Burger scholarship.

Old Business – none. New Business – none.

72 door prizes were given away.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 2:45 p.m.
